food ingredients. These initiatives exemplify the need for international collaboration in building resilient, resource-efficient solutions for future food production. This expert session reflects DLG's strategic commitment to fostering global partnerships in science and innovation, its non-profit aim since 1885.

DLG will also be represented in the Agri-Food Tech World Championship, AFTEA's flagship start-up competition. The event brings together emerging ventures in agri-tech, aqua-tech, alternative proteins, and sustainability to pitch their innovations to a panel of leading investors and industry experts.
